Assessment: Cooperating Teacher Final Evaluation

Assessment: Cooperating Teacher Final Evaluation is used by the cooperating teacher to assess candidate's proficiency during the teaching practicum using criteria in five areas. The criteria are assessed using the following scale:

Excelling (51-46) = Meets all the required elements within the criterion.

Proficient (45-41) = Partially meets the required elements within the criterion.

Acceptable (40-36) = Seldom meets the required elements within the criterion.

Unacceptable (35-) = Does not meet the required elements within the criterion.

Assessment: Cooperating Teacher Final Evaluation criteria aligned to Standard 1.

The aggregated data demonstrates that all candidates for the 2011-2012 year met the criteria at the excelling or proficient level. The evidence shows that the majority of the candidates achieved an excelling level.
